


Photo 1: Justice Minister Kamikawa receives a courtesy visit from Mr. Douglas

Mr. Douglas stated that he would like to encourage the ASEAN countries to participate in the Kyoto Congress.




Photo 2: Justice Minister Kamikawa exchanges views with Mr. Douglas
