

On February 5, 2019, Justice Minister Yamashita received a courtesy visit from H.E. Mr. Solomon Karanja Maina, the Ambassador of Kenya to Japan. An overview of the visit is as follows.

Minister Yamashita welcomed H.E. Ambassador Maina, and stated that he would like to strengthen the cooperative relation in legal affairs between the two countries.

Minister Yamashita further encouraged high level participation from Kenya in the 14th United Nations Congress on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice (the Kyoto Congress), which is to be held in Kyoto in April 2020.
